## Register Your Travel

- Register with the University of Calgary Travel Registration system at <a href="https://iac01.ucalgary.ca/RiskMgmt/">https://iac01.ucalgary.ca/RiskMgmt/</a>. This allows us to contact you if we become aware of an emergency in the country/area to which you are travelling. It also allows us to assist you if you phone the University in an emergency situation.
- Register with the Government of Canada at <a href="https://travel.gc.ca/travelling/registration">https://travel.gc.ca/travelling/registration</a>. This allows the consulate to contact you in an emergency situation.

## Download the Emergency Apps on your Smartphone and Make Note of the Emergency Phone Numbers

- Download the International SOS Assistance App for mobile phones. Visit\_
   http://app.internationalsos.com
   on your smartphone. Download the application. Enter the university's membership number 27AYCA093142. This will give you 24-hour access to telephone advice from a physician and referrals to more than 79,000 global, vetted providers for medical and security situations. It also gives you travel information and alerts for each country.
- Download the Government of Canada app Travel Smart from <a href="https://travel.gc.ca/mobile">https://travel.gc.ca/mobile</a>. This gives you access to all of their country information.
