LIST OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS, FACILITY RENTALS
AND EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIPS

- a) **Anatomy Labs – Faculty of Medicine** – instructional/educational programs.
- b) **Aquatic Centre** – facility rental and/or instructional programs that include:
- Swimming Lessons.
 - Water Fitness.
 - Water Sports.
 - Entry SCUBA.
 - Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certifications.
 - Lifesaving Society Lifesaving & Life Guarding Certifications.
 - Boating Safety and Snorkeling.
- c) **Be Fit for Life Program** – this program uses the Board's (schools) facilities.
- d) **Climbing Room** – facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- e) **Fitness Centre** – facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- f) **Gymnasiums & Gymnastics Centre** – facility rental and/or instructional programs that include volleyball, basketball, badminton and gymnastics.
- g) **Kananaskis Field Station** – instructional programs and/or meals and/or program resources and/or accommodations that include:
- Outdoor science education programs.
 - School field trips.
 - Professional development programs.
 - Ecology education programs.
 - Environmental education programs.
- NOTE: – all of the Kananaskis Field Station services may be either FULL SUPPORT (which includes instruction, meals, program resources and sometimes accommodations) OR SELF DIRECTED (which includes accommodation only).
- h) **Outdoor Program Centre** – instructional programs that include:
- Avalanche Awareness Courses – lecture presentations only.
 - Backpacking
 - Bike Repair Clinics
 - Canoeing – takes place at The University's pool and/or a school or community pool, Glenmore reservoir, Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes, the Bow River, Kananaskis River and/or in wilderness areas. If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental.
 - Cross Country Skiing – takes place at the Board's school, local parks or Kananaskis Country trails and/or in wilderness areas.
 - Guiding Services – provides guide services for hiking trips.
 - Ice climbing – takes place at the Junkyards or Kings Creek K-Country.
 - In-Line Skating
 - Kayaking – takes place at The University's pool and/or a school or community pool, Glenmore reservoir, Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes, the Bow River,

Kananaskis River and/or in wilderness areas. If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental.

- Mountain Biking – takes place on University endowment lands and/or other trail areas.
 - Outdoor Rock Climbing
 - Portable Climbing Wall – instructional programs may include setup and use of the Portable Climbing Wall at the Board's school.
 - Sea Kayaking – takes place at The University's pool and/or a school or community pool, Glenmore reservoir, Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes, the Bow River, Kananaskis River and/or in wilderness areas. If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental.
 - Snow Shelters – takes place at Fortress Mountain.
 - Snowshoeing – takes place at the Board's school, local parks or Kananaskis Country.
 - Stand Up Paddle Boarding– takes place at The University's pool and/or a school or community pool, Glenmore reservoir, Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes. The Bow River, Kananaskis River and/or in wilderness areas. If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental.
 - Telemark Skiing – takes place at Wintergreen or Nakiska.
 - Whitewater Rafting and/or River Rafting – takes place at The University's pool and/or a school or community pool, Glenmore reservoir, Bowness Lagoon and/or city lakes. The Bow River, Kananaskis River and/or in wilderness areas. If it takes place at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental.
- i) **Outdoor School** (nature walks and outdoor education) – takes place in local parks or Kananaskis Country.
- j) **Racquet Centre**
- Facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- k) **Rothney Astrophysical Observatory, Pridis, Alberta**
- Instructional/educational programs.
- l) **Skating** – takes place at Bowness Park and/or Olympic Oval
- Facility rental and/or instructional programs.
- m) **Sports Clinics**
- Football clinics and/or training camps.
 - Basketball clinics and/or training camps.
 - Volleyball clinics and/or training camps.
- n) **Spray Lake Gymnastics Centre**
- Facility rental and instructional programs that includes gymnastics.
- o) **University of Calgary Community Garden**
- Gardening activities that may include planting, weeding, digging, and watering.
- p) **University of Calgary Facility Tours**
- Touring activities that may include spaces throughout the university campuses including laboratories.

q) **Young Persons Accessing Laboratories**

- Instructional programs – this program uses the University’s facilities.
- Science Fair Mentorship Programs – this program uses the University’s facilities.
